



1st prepay sharia card is launched

THE first sharia-compliant prepaid credit card was launched yesterday. The Cordoba Gold MasterCard is available to British residents aged 18 and above. A Cordoba spokesman said: 'Normally when someone puts money on a prepaid card the company that issues the card will earn interest on the balance until the person spends it. This is not the case with Cordoba, as you can neither earn nor pay interest under sharia law.' Fully sharia-compliant banks have more than 30,000 customers across Britain.
